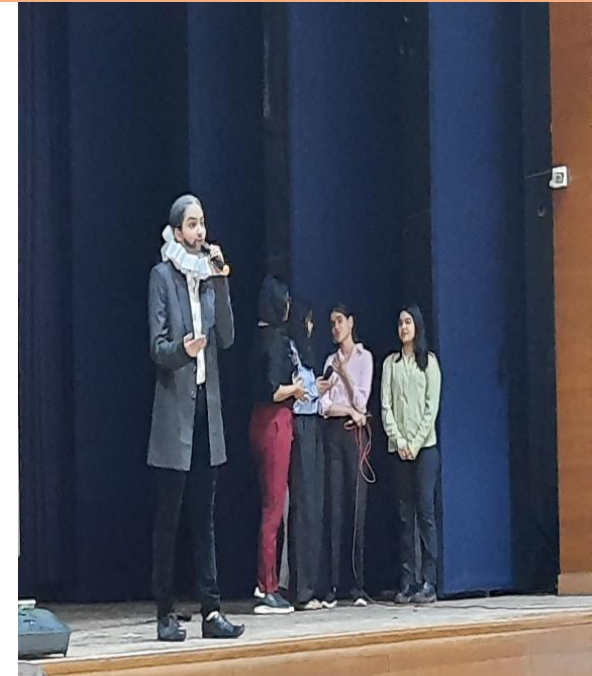
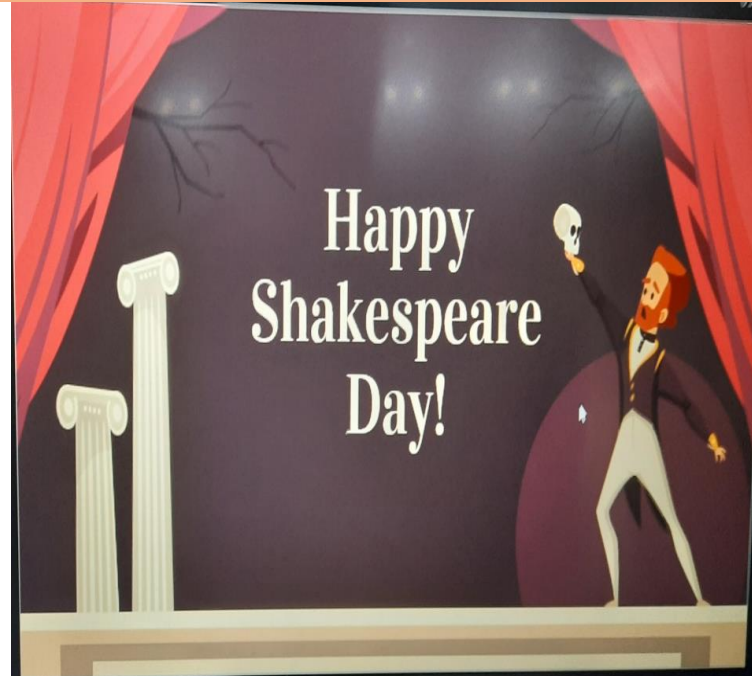
# ***THE YEAR AT A GLANCE...***

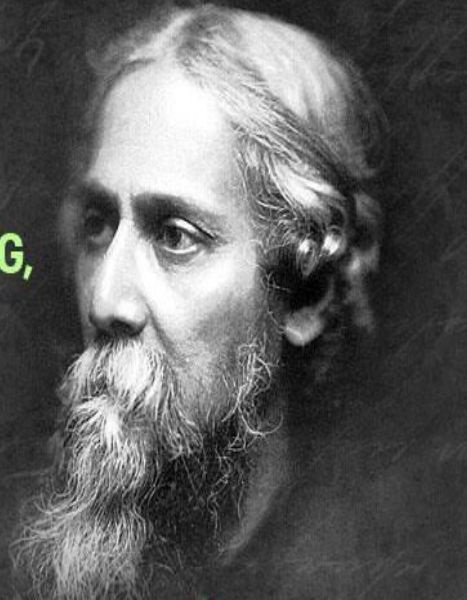

# Mere Sapnon Ka Bharat- India in 2047!

महोदय, मेरी दृष्टि में 2047 का भारत

हमारा भारत देश बड़ा ही महान देश है। आजादी से मरी श्वास लेने का अवसर पच्चीस बार 15 अगस्त 1947 में मिला था। परंतु हमें फिर से बाध्यता का शिकार होना पड़ा था। कोरोना महामारी ने इस संसार को पकड़ लिया था। हम आजादी का अमृत महोत्सव मना रहे हैं जब भारत की 100 वर्षों की आजादी पूरी हो जायगी तो यह सार के लिए एक बड़ा बड़ा अज्ञात योगी आज भी हम स्वतंत्रता दिवस बड़े ही धूम-धाम से मनाते हैं क्योंकि इस दिन हमें अंग्रेजों पर विजय पाई थी। इतने समय के अनंत प्रयास और बलिदानों के पश्चात् हमें आजादी मिल ही गई थी। हमारे नाजान कि कौन अनजान और पुरुषों और स्त्रियों ने बलिदान दिया था परंतु आज भी हम एक बहुत ही क्रम अनुचित लोक में हैं जो कि है।

महोदय,

2047 का मेरे सपनों का भारत

भारत एक अद्भुत देश है। इसका इतिहास पराक्रमी एवं न्यायप्रिय स्त्रियों और पुरुषों से भरा हुआ है। ऐसे महान देश के भविष्य के बारे में निश्चिन्ता, निन क्यारियों को वह चूम सकता है, और जिन अनंत संभावनाओं को वह प्राप्त कर सकता है, उनकी कल्पना करना एक अत्यंत सुखद एवं रोचक कार्य है।

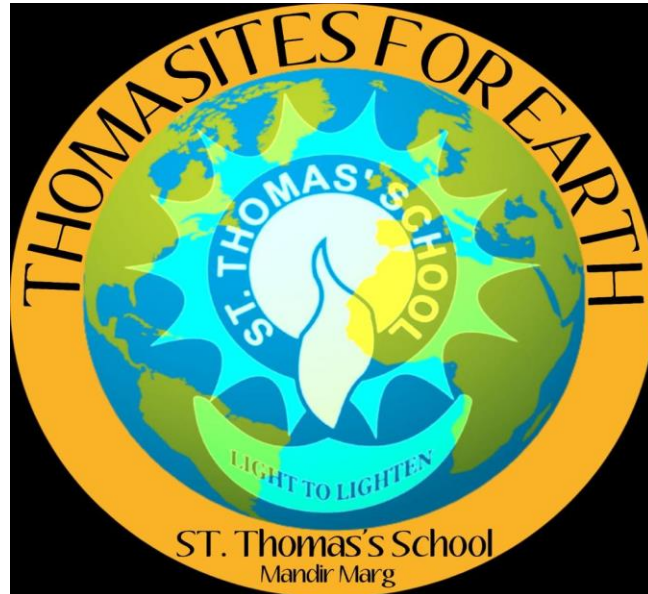
# PASSPORT TO EARNING

- We conducted the **Energy Efficiency Program** in partnership with **EESL**, a joint venture of **NTPC Ltd.** and **Power Finance Corporation**, under the **Ministry of Power**, to sensitize students to the need for **energy efficiency** and adopt ways for **energy savings** and **alternative sources of energy.**

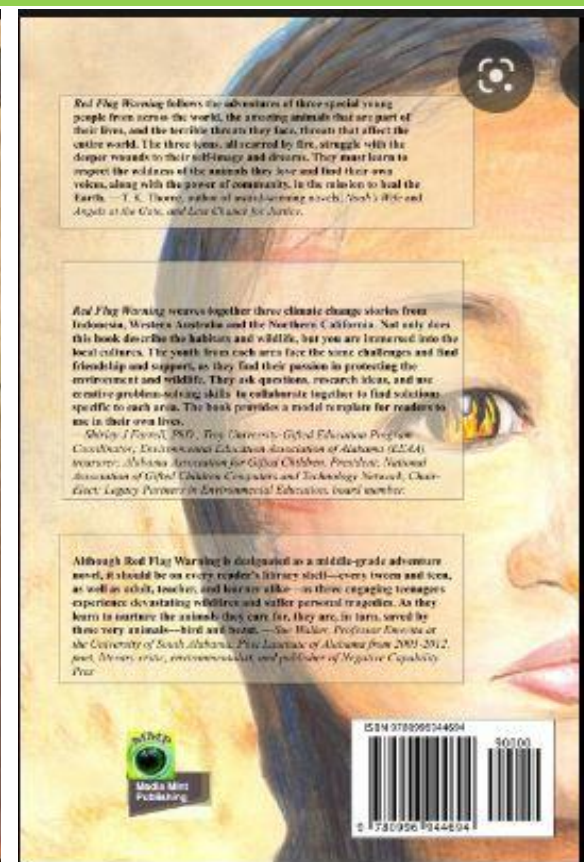
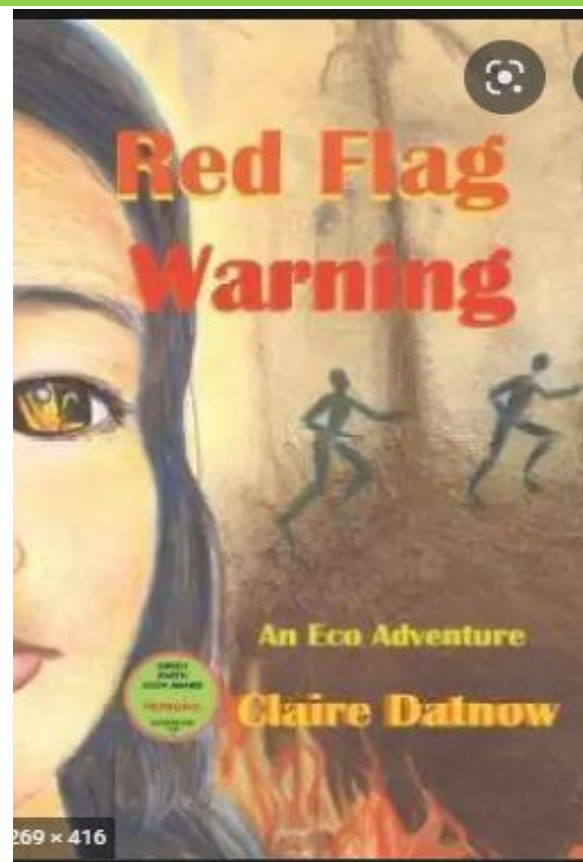
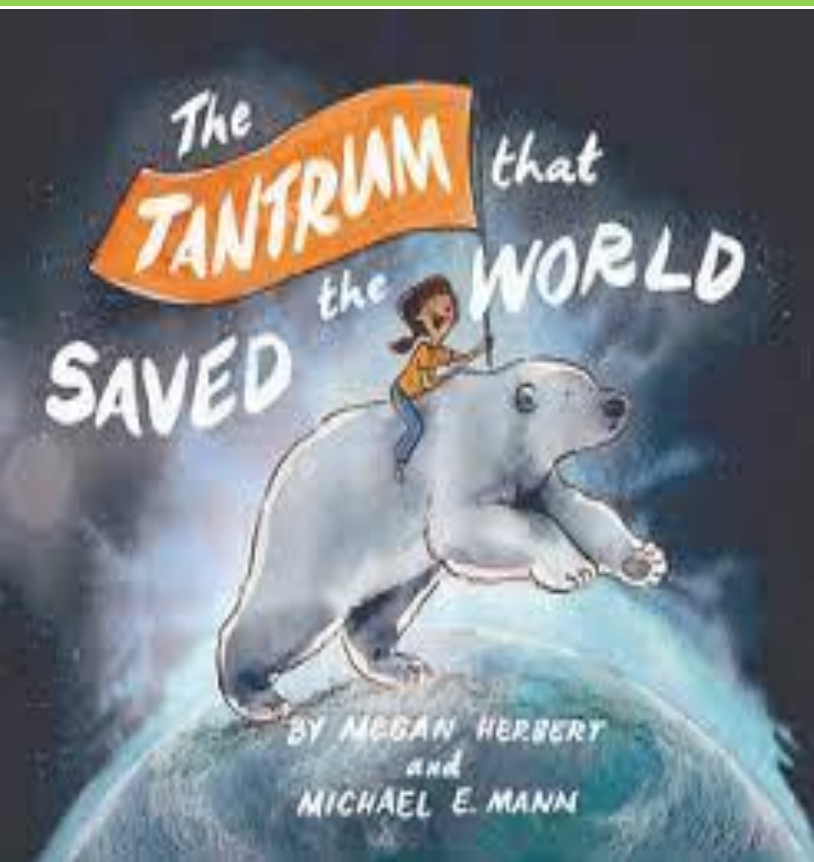


# Environment & Library Integrated Multidisciplinary project

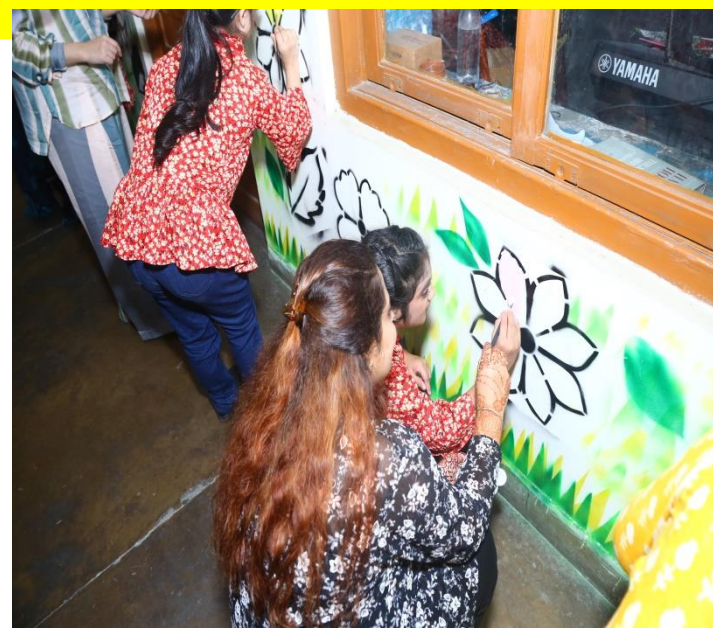
# PRERNA DAY
